1 Snowdrops and Birds of prey

Route: Libošť - Bartošovice - Sednice - Libošť
Route length: about 14 km
Time required: about 3 hours and 45 minutes
Route suitable for prams: yes
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: easy

Route description:

1. Bus stop at the Libošť, restaurace U Leidů - 0 km ☒
We take off at the bus stop in Libošť, restaurace U Leidů and we cross the road and go along the street which is now on our right side. We go straight and pass the farm house, and then

2. we continue on country road to Bartošovice
3. Bus stop at the Bartošovice, horní konec - 4 km
4. Bartošovice, the chateau - 6.5 km ☒
Sednice, snowdrops in Sednice - 9 km
We go to the right at the first turn in Sednice and walk straight along the long street. Then, we go to the right again at service garage and to the left at the end of the trail. It takes just a few metres and we are back in Libošť. At the fork we go left and then right at the next intersection. After about 300 m, we turn to the left and get to (yet) another fork.

5. Bus stop at the Libošť, u kovárny - 14 km

2 In steps of the General Laudon

Route length: about 11 km
Time required: about 2 hours and 30 minutes
Route suitable for prams: yes
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: easy

2. (Dukelská St., then Malostranská St.) in Šenov in Nový Jičín - Banner's spring - 5.5 km
3. (Malostranská St.) Šenov in Nový Jičín - St. Martin Church - 7.5 km
4. (Malostranská St.) Kunín - chateau - 11 km ☒

3 Walk along the Oder River meanders to Jeseník mineral springs

Route: Suchdol nad Odrou - Jeseník nad Odrou
Route length: about 7 km
Time required: about 1 hour and 45 minutes
Route suitable for prams: no
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: easy

Route description:

1. Suchdol nad Odrou - 0 km ☒
2. Bernartice - 4 km
We leave the yellow marks before Bernartice and turn to the right along to the Oder River meanders. We then walk to Jeseník nad Odrou
3. Jeseník nad Odrou - 7 km ☒

4 From Jeseník mineral springs to Virgin Mary of Lourdes

Route: Jeseník nad Odrou - Hůrka - Starojická Lhota - Janovice - Petřkovice
Route length: about 13 km
Time required: about 3 hours and 30 minutes
Route suitable for prams: no
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: medium

2. Fork at Hůrka - 3 km
3. Below Hůrka - 4.5 km

5 From Celtic fortified settlement to a classicistic chateau

Route: Kojetín - Petřkovická hora (Mountain) - Perná - Chateau Lešná
Route length: about 8 km
Time required: about 2 hours and 30 minutes
Route suitable for prams: yes
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: easy

Route description:

1. Fork in Kojetín - 0 km
2. Strážnice - 0.5 km
3. Petřkovická hora (Mountain) - 2.5 km

4. Fork in Perná/Jasenice - 5 km
5. Bus stop in Perná, the farm - 6.5 km
6. Chateau in Lešná - 8 km

TOP POINT OF INTEREST ON THE ROUTE:

Lešná Chateau (the chateau built in the middle of the 14th century shows the classicistic character and romantic neogothic details)

Other interesting places on the route:

The historical lime tree at Kojetín, the Celtic fortified settlement Požaha, and the view point on the Petřkovická hora

6 To Domorazy forests, Smradlavka and Kyselka (mineral springs)

Route: Nový Jičín - Skalky - Čerták - Straník - Hostašovice - River Zrzávka springs
Route length: about 12 km
Time required: about 4 hours
Route suitable for prams: no
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: medium

Route description:

1. Nový Jičín railway station - 0 km
2. Masaryk Square in Nový Jičín - 0.5 km ☒
3. Nový Jičín, the amphitheatre Skalky - 2.5 km ☒
4. Nový Jičín, the fork at Skalky - 3.5 km

5. Straník fork - 7 km
6. Hostašovice, River Zrzávka springs - 12 km ☒

Historical City Site in Nový Jičín, the recreation area of Skalky, the water reservoir Čerták, a spring called the Queen of Heavens in Straník, and the cushion lava in Straník

7 Around the Little Cross to the Castle

Route: Nový Jičín - Skalky - Svinec - Starý (Old) Jičín
Route length: about 8 km
Time required: about 2 hours and 45 minutes
Route suitable for prams: no
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: medium

Route description:

1. Nový Jičín railway station - 0 km
2. Masaryk Sq. in Nový Jičín - 0.5 km ☒
3. Nový Jičín - Amphitheatre Skalky - 2.5 km ☒
4. Svinec - Ski slope - 4 km ☒
5. Svinec top - 5 km
6. Starý (Old) Jičín - Castle - 8 km ☒

TOP POINT OF INTEREST ON THE ROUTE:

Ruins of the Starý Jičín Castle (the castle built at the end of the 12th century which served mostly to military for the protection of the so-called Amber Trail)

Historical City Site in Nový Jičín, the recreation area Skalky, the Svinec view point, and the Oční (Eye) spring

Route length: 10 km
Time required: about 3 hours

9 Along the Oder River to the watermill

Route: Suchdol nad Odrou - Hladké Žitovice - Bartošovice
Route length: about 15 km
Time required: about 4 hours
Route suitable for prams: no
Route suitable for families with children: yes
Classification: medium

1. Suchdol nad Odrou - 0 km ☒
2. Hladké Žitovice, the Krivý potok fork - 4.5 km
3. Hladké Žitovice, the fork at the railway station - 7 km
4. Pustějov, the fork at the pond - 10 km
5. Fork in Bartošovice (the watermill) - 12.5 km

6. Bartošovice Municipality Centre - 15 km ☒
